- Cardboard boxes, cereal, muesli and other food cartons and packaging.

### Paper

### Paper

Remove staples and sticky tape and any plastic windows

- Magazines, newspapers, brochures, leaflets, office paper, envelopes.

### All Glass



Bottles / Jars



### Glass Bottles & Jars

Lids off and washed, corks removed

- Jars
- Beer and wine bottles
- Pasta sauce and oil bottles

### Cans



Tin / Steel



### Tins and Cans

Washed and squashed

- Soft drink cans
- Food tins
- Beer cans

Containers



### Plastic 1 - PET

Lids off, washed and squashed

- Soft drink, juice and water bottles
- Cooking oil and vinegar
- Fruit punnets & some takeaway containers

### Plastic 2 - HDPE

Lids off, washed and squashed

- Milk bottles
- Sauce bottles
- Detergent and shampoo bottles

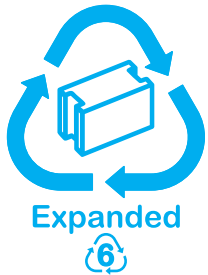


### Plastic containers number 3 to 7

Washed and squashed, lids off

- Yoghurt, margarine bottles & pottles
- Honey and peanut butter containers
- Ice cream containers and lids
- Take away containers and lids

### Expanded Polystyrene

White polystyrene, all cello tape & labels to be removed

- Clean boxes
- Protective packaging
- **Not meat trays & takeaway containers**

## Plastic



### Plastic Wrap

Clear & coloured (separated)

- Shrink wrap
- Bulk wrapping
- Silage plastic
- **Not plastic bags**

### Separate Wheelie Bins for

- **Red** - Paper
- **Grey** - Glass
- **Sky Blue** - Glass/Plastic/Cans
- **Dark Blue** - Plastic/Cans

### Separate Green Sacks for

- **Paper**
- **Cardboard**
- **Plastics / Cans**

### Separate Wool Sacks for

- **Cardboard**
- **Polystyrene**
- **Plastics / Cans**
- **Plastic Wrap**
